2006 Was the First Year Degrees Were Awarded

- 35 classes in three levels of difficulty were offered
- 67 paid students, 23 Instructors and Staff (many attended classes as well)
- 17 Associations were represented

Student Feedback

2006 STUDENT CLASS SURVEY

- 259 class surveys were completed by students
- 181 gave a top rating on the question: "I feel the registration fee was fair for what I am receiving in return"
- 83% gave their class Excellent or Good Ratings

Suggestions for Improvement
