RULE XIV IGRA DIVISIONS, RODEOS, AND RODEO APPROVAL

Section 2. A rodeo shall be a one or two day go-round activity, **conducted over one, two, or three days.**

RULE XV INTERNATIONAL FINALS RODEO

Section 3. Finals Rodeo Fund.

A. There shall be an escrow fund funded from sanction fee of fifty cents (\$.50) per single rodeo performance ticket sold during the rodeo year (see Standing Rule XIV IGRA Divisions, Rodeos, and Rodeo Approval, Section 3, Paragraph B) and fifty cents (\$.50) per event/per day go-round/per contestant entry fee (see Rodeo Rule II Registration, Number 13).

13. Entry fees for IGRA-sanctioned rodeos will be twenty-three dollars (\$23.00) per person, per day go-round, per event to be distributed as follows:
 - A. Sixteen dollars (\$16.00) to contestant purse money.
 - B. Four dollars (\$4.00) to the host association.
 - C. Two dollars (\$2.00) to be held in escrow by IGRA to be used as purse money for the IGRA Finals Rodeo.
 - D. Fifty cents (\$.50) to be held in escrow by IGRA to be used for the sole purpose of financing an arena for IGRA Finals Rodeo (see Standing Rule XIV – IGRA Finals Rodeo, Section 2).
 - E. Fifty cents (\$.50) to the IGRA general fund.

14. Entry fees for IGRA Finals Rodeo will be twenty-three dollars (\$23.00) per person, per day go-round, per event and will be combined with any contestant money held in escrow (see Rodeo Rule II – Registration, Number 10 Entries, Paragraph F).
