**Public Benefit Activities**

In 2022, the IGRA sanctioned ten regional member rodeo events, plus four rodeo schools and the annual ***World Gay Rodeo Finals™***, held in El Reno, OK. In this year, each regional rodeo engaged 25-75 contestants. This lower than usual number may be due to recovery from two years of limited activity due to the Covid-19 restrictions. Each rodeo school engaged approximately 20-25 new, or existing members.

IGRA held its 2022 annual convention in Denton, Tx. The organization conducted normal business committee meetings and convention proceedings, including the election of the 2023-2024 President and Treasurer. Primary funding came from the production of the WGRF rodeo, fundraising activities of the

IGRA royalty team, and member dues as outlined in the summery public financial report.

In 2022, IGRA was able to clarify, correct, and re-establish 501C3 status with the United States Internal Revenue Service, and is now in full compliance with those regulations.
